- Current NRA or USCCA Instructor: Submit a copy of your current NRA PPIH or USCCA credentials.
- Current Michigan Attorney or Michigan LEO: Submit a copy of your State Bar or MCOLES credentials.
- Non-Instructor: Non-instructors must first take the MCRGO CPL class from any MCRGO instructor prior to taking an instructor workshop. If you have already taken a MCRGO CPL class, submit your class certificate. This can be submitted after this application is approved if you have not taken this class yet. All credentials must include an expiration date that has not yet be reached. MCRGO will not make exceptions to the training paths for expired credentials or provide waivers based on other credentials not listed above. For non-instructor candidates, only a MCRGO certificate will be accepted (not other agencies).
