The Michigan Coalition for Responsible Gun Owners is the largest state-based firearms advocate in America. We at MCRGO strongly believe that the greater the ratio of legal gun owners to armed criminals in a community, the lower the rate of violent crime will be. Consequently, we support removing legal barriers that restrict the natural right of self-defense and oppose legislation which would disarm legal gun owners.

2020 MCRGO-PAC PROCESS

Candidates running as a Democrat, Libertarian, or Republican for the August 2020 primary are asked to fill out the information below, sign this page and answer the 10 yes/no questions on this back. Surveys must be postmarked by Monday, June 29, 2020. There will be no outright endorsements in the primary election. Instead, candidates will be rated based on their responses to this survey. Incumbent candidates may also have their ratings adjusted based on their votes on firearms related legislation during the current legislative session. No ratings will be adjusted, added, or removed following the August primary election. Candidates who fail to submit a survey will not receive a rating or be eligible for endorsement in the general election.

Candidates who are successful in the primary election will not need to fill out another survey. Instead, endorsements for the November general election will be based off of ratings from the primary election along with any bill sponsorships or votes that occur after the primary election (for incumbents). Ratings and endorsements are made by a balanced multi-partisan PAC committee with no preference shown for political affiliation. No direct bias is given to incumbents over their challengers although incumbents with a clear progun or anti-gun legislative history will have their ratings adjusted as a result of that history.
